- STEM Scholars are exceptional youth between the ages of 17-30 pursuing undergraduate/graduate degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics at one of our 15 top-tier partner universities.
- OLSP Scholars are young professionals upgrading their specialization with an online master's program at Arizona State University (ASU).

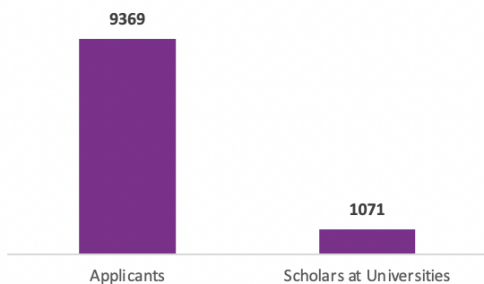

Competitive Application Process

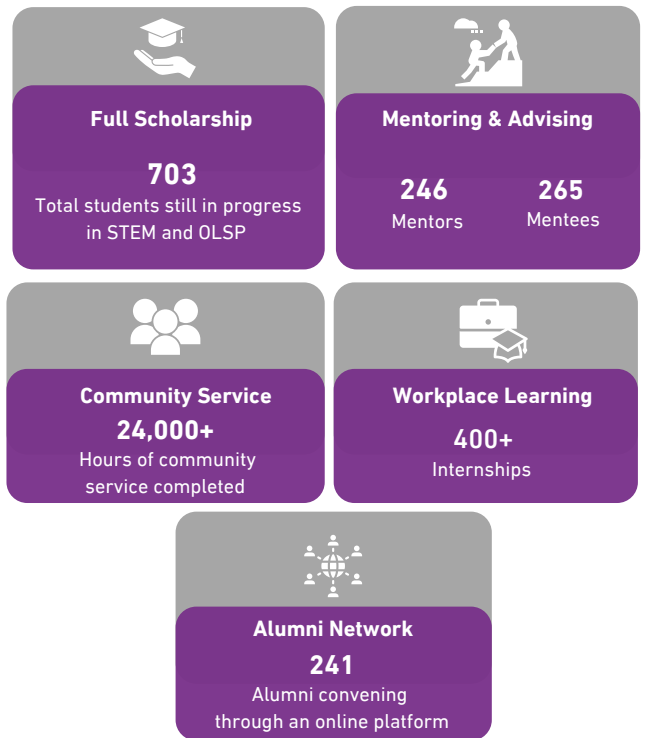
The scholars were selected through a rigorous application followed by a six-week selection process to determine students who are both high academic achievers and in most financial need.
