The Abdulla Al Ghurair Foundation published an Internship Guide to support students in the internship application process; employers in establishing impactful internship programs; and universities in enhancing student preparation for experiential learning programs.

Based on interviews with employers in the private sector, the guide outlines that internships are essential in bringing new perspectives into organizations, enhancing productivity, and supporting Emiratization requirements as well as local talent pipelines, among others.

Interns are 32% more likely to be retained than new hires without internship experience. (National Association of Colleges and Employers)

78% of employers in the MENA region are looking to hire an intern in 2023 and 65% always offer a full-time job to the intern. (<u>Bayt.com</u>)

56% of interns and 40% of co-op students became full-time, entry-level hires in 2019. (National Association of Colleges and Employers)

- ✓ Build a structured program by having documented policies
- ✓ Assign meaningful tasks for interns that will lead to specific outcomes
- ✓ Listen to the intern's needs to motivate them and improve retention

- √ Tailor your resume to highlight relevant skills and experiences
- ✓ Seek additional responsibilities and learning opportunities during your internship
- ✓ Reflect on the key skills and knowledge you gained during your internship
